Then we just have the thing for you!

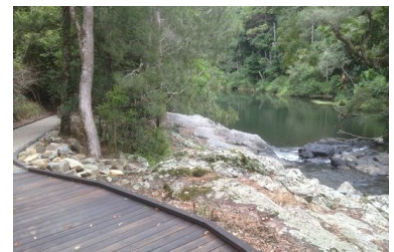
